

Thorns - Program Note

Thorns was commissioned for Magdalene, a chamber opera in 13 movements conceived by soprano Danielle Birrittella and director Zoe Aja Moore and premiered at the 2020 PROTOTYPE Festival in New York, NY.

Magdalene is wild meditation on transformation and desire scored by the collective voices of fourteen women. Set to Marie Howe's Magdalene poems, the opera invites an audience into the interior world of Mary Magdalene — enlarging her to cross time and space, she appears as a woman alive now, who strives to heal the unyielding split between the sacred and the sexual. Encountering her life in flashes – wandering through a hotel, lighting birthday candles, making love in the ocean – Magdalene finds transcendence in the mundane to finally become the subject of her own story.
